Distance Learning Technology & Technical Support

The four primary software products currently used for course delivery at Athens State University are as follows:



Athens State incorporates **Blackboard Learn™** as its official platform for on-line course delivery. Blackboard is a course management system designed to enhance your learning experience and to promote collaborative engagement throughout your educational career at the university.

All internet-based and blended courses, as well as some land-based courses will require you to use Blackboard on a regular basis throughout each semester. Instructors employ Blackboard within their courses to varying degrees, and may at their discretion enlist the following institutionally-supported software to further enhance their courses for your benefit.



The **Wimba Collaboration Suite** is a rich array of collaborative tools that allow instructors to deliver the highly personal and lively nature of traditional classroom instruction for you to experience in an enhanced online environment. From voice to video, podcasting to content authoring and instant messaging, Wimba works seamlessly within existing Blackboard courses to further enhance your learning experiences.



Respondus LockDown Browser™ is a downloadable application used for taking your exams over the Internet. If required by your instructor, you must download LockDown Browser from our website at www.athens.edu/blackboard and install it onto your computer. A successful installation of the software will result in the placement of a “padlock” icon on your computer's desktop, which you must click to take your test at the appropriate examination time. It is highly suggested that you install the software the first week of the semester, long before your first exam, in order to sufficiently resolve any technical issues you may encounter.



Tegrity Campus allows you to playback any class session or lecture which has been recorded by your instructor, in part or whole. Audio & video can be streamed over the internet or downloaded to an external video player (iPod, MP3) for off-line studying. If your instructor has provided video sessions you're your review, they may be accessed by clicking the “Tegrity Classes” link/button in the Blackboard course menu.
