

College of Education Courses and Field Experience Requirements

Students are required to enter on the online application the number of days required for each course.

If the number of days exceeds 10, then the Field Experience Office will cap the days at 10 when the placement information is released.

- **Elementary** majors are capped at **10 days**.
- **Early Childhood** majors will be capped at **10 days** (this is a change from the 8 days that were previously assigned). Many early childhood courses require additional preschool observations. The additional preschool observations will be assigned by the individual early childhood professors.

MAXIMUM NUMBER of required days for field experience per semester – **10**

EXCEPTION

- **Secondary** majors will complete all assigned field experience days. **There will NOT be a cap on the total number of days.**
