Eligibility is open to all RFCU members in good standing (excluding RFCU employees and elected members of the Board of Directors of RFCU or an immediate family member of an RFCU employee or elected member of the Board of Directors of RFCU).

- The member must be attending an accredited college or university for the Fall 2010 Semester.
- The applicant must be a primary member of RFCU in good standing (not a joint member).

■ Application Process:

To apply, eligible members will need to provide the following items:

- Typed (or neatly printed) and fully completed application (*fillable .pdf version online at www.redfcu.org*)
- Student copy of your academic transcript (*must reflect cumulative GPA*)
- Signed Letter of Recommendation from a non-family member (*please include relationship to applicant*)
- Essay - **Describe your past and present financial institution experiences. How has RFCU played a role and how do you envision RFCU playing a role in the future?** (*Minimum 250 words & maximum 500 words, typed, double-spaced, 12 pt. font*)

■ Selection Process:

All eligible applications will be evaluated by the Scholarship Committee and applicants will be notified of the Committee's decision no later than May 31.

■ Application Deadline:

Applications must be postmarked or hand-delivered by March 1, 2010.
