SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONAL REQUEST (S.I.R.)

STUDENTS MAY REGISTER FOR A S.I.R. CLASS UNTIL December 6. It is the student's responsibility to check Calhoun's schedule for beginning class date.

ASU and Calhoun Community College cooperate in a Special Instructional Request (S.I.R.) program. Grades are reported to the ASU Records Office and recorded on the student's Athens State University transcript. **Student is subject to English and/or mathematics placement exam (ASSET) at Calhoun. Students are not permitted to participate in S.I.R. during their final semester at ASU. (S.I.R students are not allowed to take Calhoun telecourses.)S.I.R. classes will not be counted as senior level courses in the general college requirements for graduation.**

To participate in this program, the ASU student:

1. must be deficient in one of the courses in the General Students Curriculum Core I-V.
2. must receive approval of advisor.
3. must receive a copy of S.I.R. Form during registration.
4. must pay ASU tuition for the S.I.R. course.
5. **must process all S.I.R. (withdrawals) in ASU Admissions Office.**
6. must register for an ASU course for every S.I.R. course.
7. cannot register on-line. Must register in Admissions Office.
8. cannot register for internet classes or telecourses.

After meeting with faculty advisor, students registering for a S.I.R. course must go the Vice President of Academic Affairs's office to receive a reference number for the S.I.R. This should be done prior to presenting registration form to the Admissions Office. At the end of the semester, students could receive incompletes in SIR classes. These will be changed as soon as grades from Calhoun have been received in the Records Office.

CONSORTIUM AGREEMENT

Athens State University participates in a Consortium Agreement with The University of Alabama in Huntsville, Alabama A&M University and Oakwood College. Students are not permitted to participate in the Consortium Agreement during their final semester at ASU. (Distance Learning classes excluded.)

To participate in this program:

1. The student must be considered a full-time student at Athens State University.
2. The course to be taken must not be available to the student in his home institution and in his approved schedule and curriculum plan.
3. The student may take only one (1) consortium course per semester.
4. The student must maintain a "C" average.
5. The student must secure faculty advisor's approval for the course to be taken.
6. The student may request participation only during pre- and regular registration.
7. The student must not participate in Consortium during final semester in which graduation at Athens State University is anticipated.
8. The student cannot register for this course online.

Federal Refund Policy

Federal refund regulations require Financial Aid Students receiving Pell Grant, Federal SMART grant, Federal Supplemental Education Opportunity Grant or Federal Direct Loans, and **withdrawing from all of his or her classes prior to the 60% point in the term**, to immediately repay any unearned federal aid dollars to the program providing those funds. The following formula is used to compute aid to be returned:

$$\text{Days Enrolled} \times \text{Title IV Aid Awarded and Disbursed} = \text{Aid Earned}$$

$$\text{Aid Disbursed} - \text{Aid Earned} = \text{Aid to be Returned}$$

- Unsubsidized Loans (per promissory note terms)
- Subsidized Loans (per promissory note terms)
 - Pell Grant * 50%
 - FSEOG
 - Federal SMART grant

NOTES:

This Policy does not limit the Policy mandated by the Alabama Department of Postsecondary Education. **ALL REFUNDS ARE CALCULATED AND PROCESSED BY BUSINESS OFFICE PERSONNEL.**

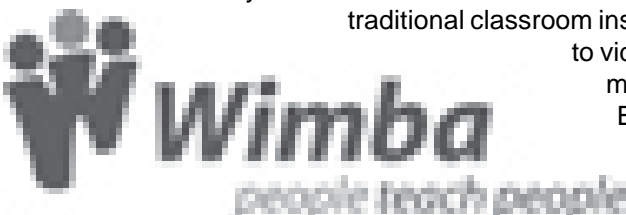

REFUND POLICY

The tuition and fees refund policy used by Athens State University is mandated by the Alabama State Board of Education. ASU is obligated to abide by the State Board Policy 803.02 dated 3-26-98. The following outline summarizes the State Board's regulations:

PRIOR TO THE FIRST DAY OF SEMESTER: 100% refund for any and all classes dropped.

DROP/ADD PERIOD: January 7-11, 2008

Partial withdrawal - 100% refund, less 5% administration fee.
 Complete withdrawal - 75% refund, less 5% administration fee.

1st WEEK AFTER DROP/ADD: January 12-18, 2008

Partial withdrawal - NO REFUND.
 Complete withdrawal - 50% refund, less 5% administration fee.

2nd WEEK AFTER DROP/ADD: January 19-25, 2008

Partial withdrawal - NO REFUND.
 Complete withdrawal - 25% refund, less 5% administration fee.

IMPORTANT: There is no refund due to a student who partially withdraws after the official drop/add period. Refunds are calculated based upon the status of enrollment at the end of the third week of the semester. **The first day of class is defined as the day the semester begins, not necessarily a student's first class meeting date. There is only one "FIRST DAY" per semester.** All refund checks will be "mailed" within three weeks from the first day of the semester.
