Information: Two scholarships will be awarded during each academic year for interns: one elementary or collaborative K-6 or early childhood and one secondary (\$150) or collaborative 6-12 or physical education or career technical education (\$150). To qualify, applicants must: (a) be a current member of the Rho Gamma Chapter (in good standing), (b) be doing internship the year that the scholarship is awarded, and (c) turn in completed application forms to:

Only the two applicants who receive the scholarships will be notified.

Selection: The selection committee will consist of two elementary professors, two secondary professors, and one administrator.

Also, send 6 copies of a two-page essay answering the following questions:

- 1. How will you use the money that you receive to enhance your internship?**
- 2. How has your service to the Rho Gamma Chapter support the ideals of toil and service?**

Criteria: Applicants will be rated on a scale of 1-5 in three categories:

- (a) overall quality of essay (appearance, content, grammar, spelling)**
- (b) perception of how the scholarship will enhance the internship, and**
- (c) quality and/or quality of service to the local chapter.**
