ABET Visit

- Bachelor of Science in Computer Science
- Bachelor of Science in Information Technology
 - Accredited to September 30, 2028
- Information Technology
 - Concern
 - Number of classes being used for assessment
 - Number of data samples collected for assessment



Graduate Programs

- Taught by CS/IT program faculty
- Fall 2022: 5 students
- Spring 2023: 9 new applicants

Cybersecurity Lab



- Appropriation of \$250K from the State of Alabama for a Cybersecurity Lab on main campus
- University facility designed for use by cybersecurity programs in the CoAS, CoB, and CLL
- Multiple phase project, with state appropriation paying for Phase 1
 - Emphasis on infrastructure needed to support traditional, hybrid, and asynchronous on-line instruction
 - Including both lab and data center enhancements
